- 1. Select a Term and Section to populate the Assignment and Student lists.
- 2. Select an Assignment.
- 3. Indicate if the results should **Include Unscored Rubrics**. This option generates a copy of an unscored rubric for each unscored student selected.
- 4. Indicate if the results should **Print in Color**. Selected cells print in blue, instead of in lower-ink gray tones.
- 5. Select **Double-Sided Printing** to print on both sides of the page. This option includes page breaks so that rubrics for different students print on separate sheets of paper.
- 6. Unmark any **Students** who should not be included in results. Filter the student list by entering



a Student Group if desired.

7. Click **Generate PDF** to view the report in PDF format or click the arrow button next to **Generate** to select a different format.
