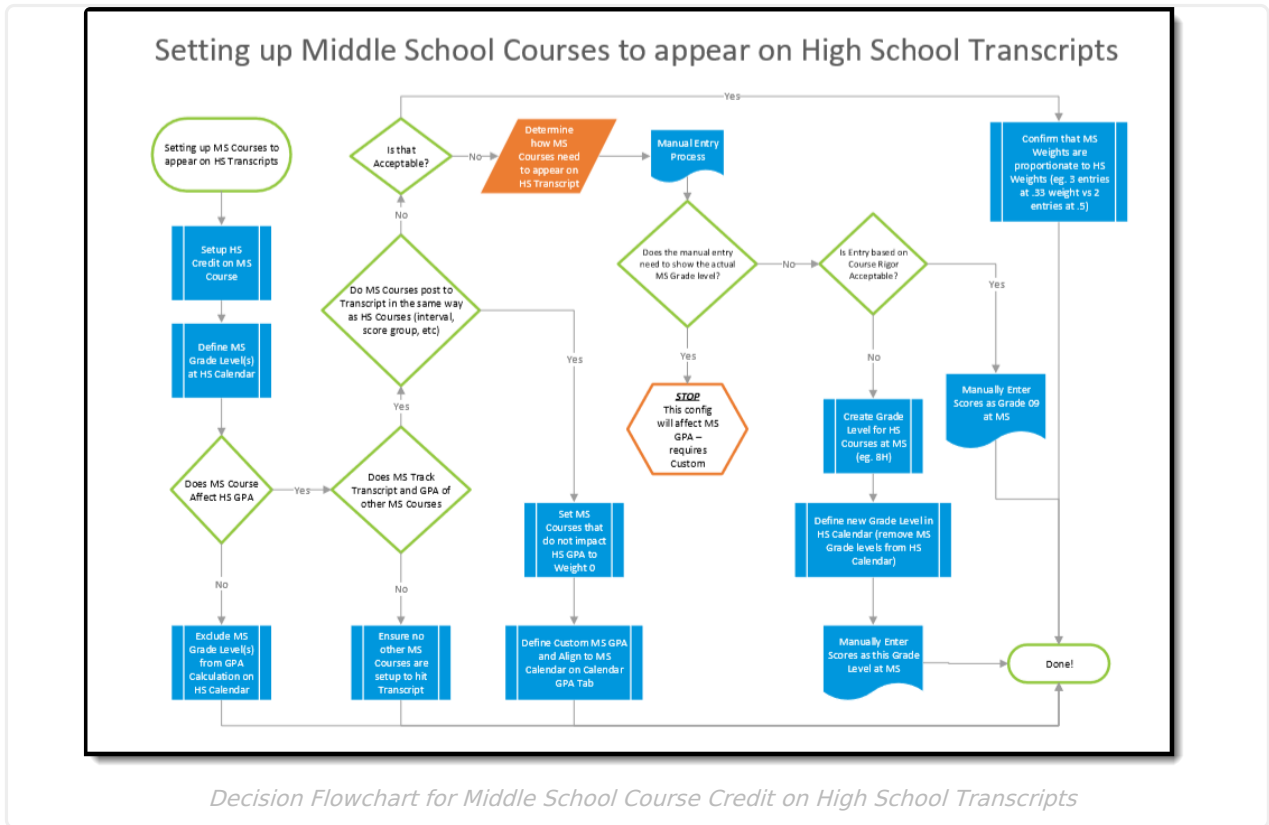
Decision Flowchart | Middle School Transcript Setup

Middle school students may receive high school credit for certain courses. In order for their transcript to reflect these courses and have their credit totals accurately reflect courses taken in middle school, the Courses and the Calendar require specific settings.

Use the [Transcript Post](#) tool to add these courses to the student's Transcript record.





Decision Flowchart

<p>Middle School Calendar <i>Ensure the middle school calendar is selected in the Campus toolbar.</i></p>		
<p>2. Add the High School Credit Group to the Middle School.</p>	<p>System Administration > Resources > Resources > School Standards</p>
