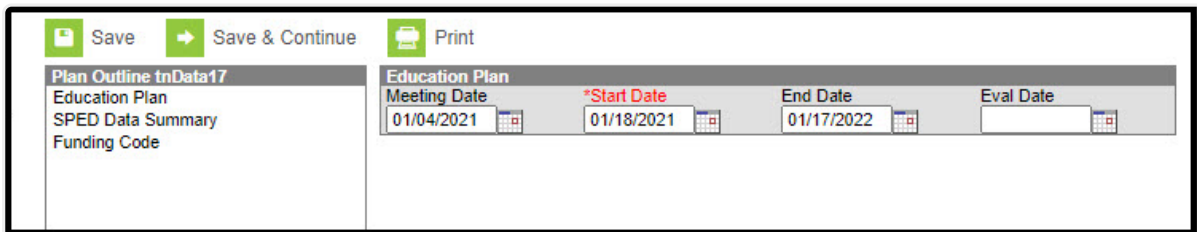


Image 1: Education Plan Editor

<b>Start Date</b> <i>Required</i>	The day on which the plan begins for the student.	Learner Planning > Learning Plans > planStartDate
<b>End Date</b>	The last day when the plan ends for the student.	Learner Planning > Learning Plans > planEndDate
<b>Eval Date</b>	The day of the student's most recent evaluation.	Learner Planning > Evaluations > evalDate

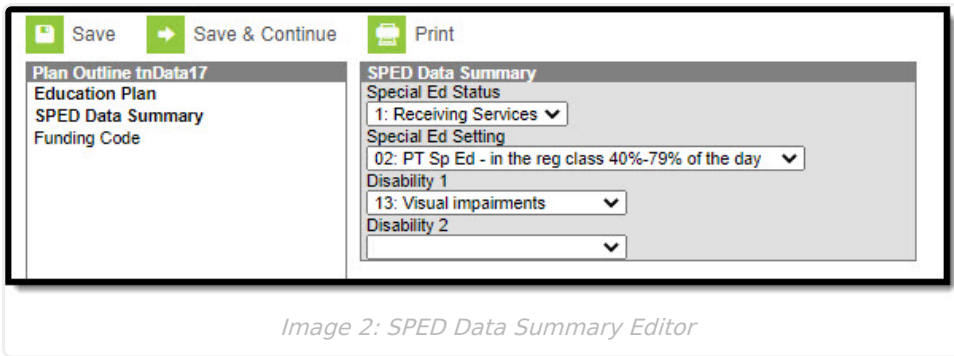


Image 2: SPED Data Summary Editor

<b>Disability 1</b>	The primary disability of the student.	Learner Planning > Learning Plans > disability 1
<b>Disability 2</b>	The second disability of the student, if applicable.	Learner Planning > Learning Plans > disability2

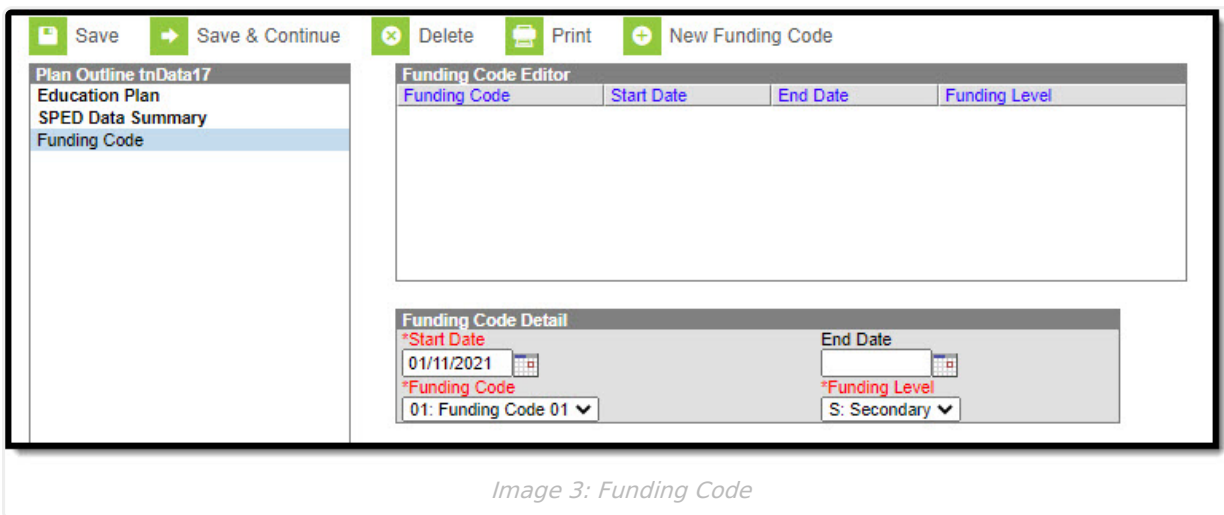


Image 3: Funding Code

<b>End Date</b>	The last day of the funding level.

Field	Description
<b>Funding Code</b> <i>Required</i>	The Funding Code is reported on the <a href="#">Tennessee ADA/ADM Report</a> . Students with Funding Codes 07, 08, and 09 are aggregated together and reported in Grade 'N'.
<b>Funding Level</b> <i>Required</i>	The funding level associated with the Funding Code.
