The Instruction Mode tool allows districts to record the learning environment for the student and to track how assignments are being used based on the CARES Act Participation field.

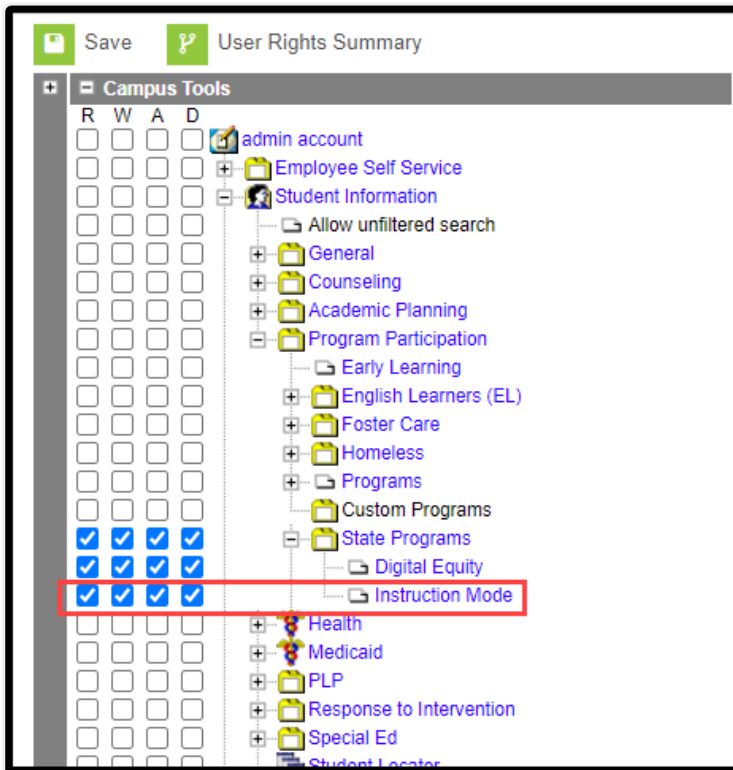

Full rights to Instruction Mode require the following:

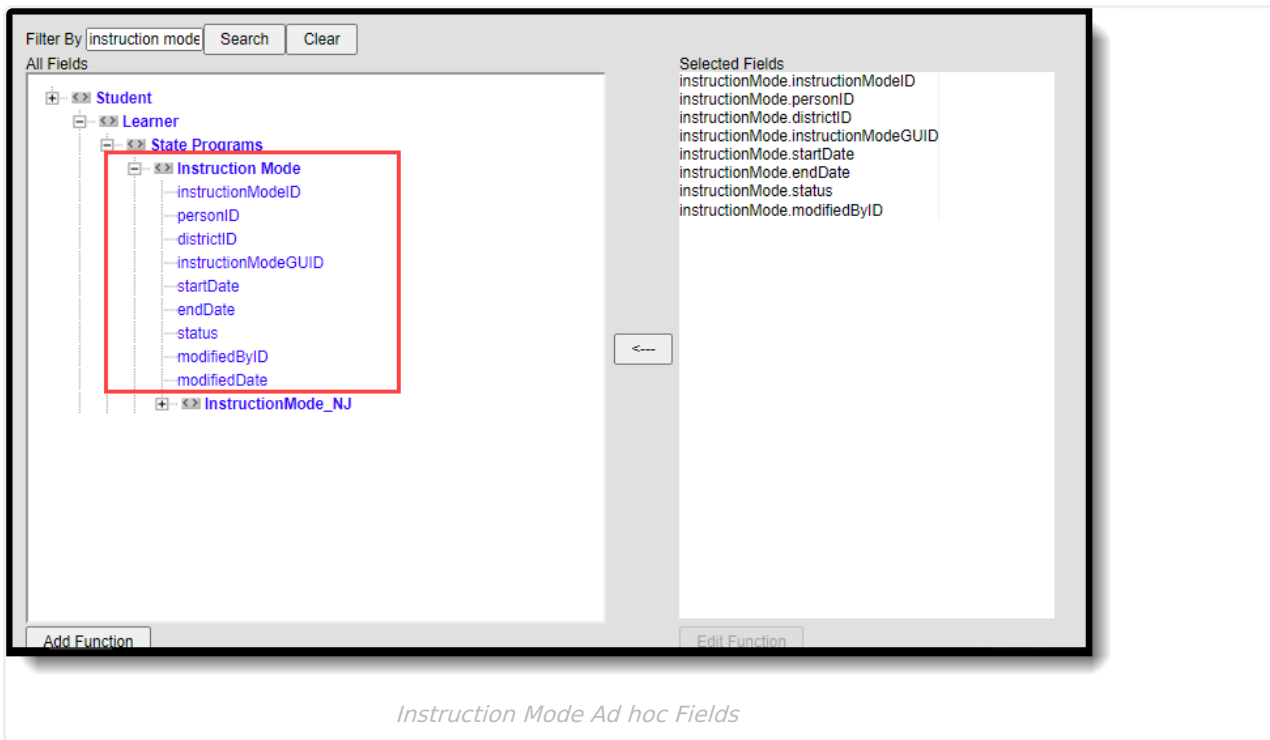
- **R**(ead) tool rights to view records

- **D**(elete) tool rights to remove a record
