The English Learners (EL) tools allow schools and districts to manage student EL programs, assessments, services, and accommodations. The EL tool provides a central location for managing EL information such as the date the student was identified as EL, when the student entered/exited an EL program, when the student is expected to leave an EL program and First Year/Second Year Monitoring data. For students who exited and/or re-entered an EL program, an historical record is kept and displayed on the tool which can be viewed in both State and District Editions of Infinite Campus.

The Indiana Department of Education refers to English Learners as Multilingual Learners (ML) as a more inclusive term that represents the student population. Note that tools within Infinite Campus use the English Learners (EL) terminology at this time.
