Restraint Reason

Indicates that a student was physically or mechanically restrained due to imminent serious physical harm to themselves or others, imminent serious property destruction, or a combination of both imminent serious physical harm to themselves or others and imminent serious property destruction or was restrained by a law enforcement officer providing a police presence at a school campus or at a school related activity at the request or direction of the LEA.

Restraint Staff Type indicates the kind of school staff person who performed a student restraint.

Campus ID of Restraint indicates the unique campus identification number of the campus at which a special education student was restrained for emergency purposes.
