## Overview

**PATH:** *Census > People > Feeder Import*

The Feeder Import Custom tab is used to list student information from non-Infinite Campus districts that send (feed) students to an Infinite Campus district. This field is populated after importing a file using the [Feeder Import Wizard](#).




Image 1: Custom Tab - Feeder Import

## Feeder Import Tab Data Elements

This tab does not have to be created manually. When the Feeder Tools are purchased, this tab and the Feeder Export custom tab will automatically be available for users. This tab can be used to review the imported data prior to creating an enrollment in the next school calendar. Because the

Feeder Import does not create household information or relationships, the data populated here can be reviewed for accuracy and modified to fit into district format.

If additional fields are desired, users can add these fields by accessing the [Custom Attribute](#) tool in System Administration. This also means that the import file used would need to contain the added fields.

The following fields are available automatically.

Field	Definition	Field Location
<b>Sending District</b>	Name of district where student is currently enrolled.	Not available in Campus.
<b>Sending School</b>	Name of school where student is currently enrolled.	Not available in Campus.
<b>Export Date</b>	Date student data was exported, based on the file imported in the Feeder Import Wizard.	Not available in Campus.
<b>Target School</b>	Name of school student is expected to attend in the next school year.	Not available in Campus.
<b>Family Enrolled</b>	Selection indicates another member of that student's family is enrolled in the district.	Not available in Campus.
<b>Parent First Name</b>	First name of parent/guardian.	Census > People > Relationships
<b>Parent Last Name</b>	Last name of parent/guardian.	Census > People > Relationships
<b>Parent Middle Name</b>	Middle name of parent/guardian.	Census > People > Relationships
<b>Home Phone</b>	Home phone number of the household.	Census > Households > Household Info
<b>Parent Email</b>	Email address of the parent/guardian.	Census > People > Demographics > Personal Contact Information
<b>Address 1</b>	House number, street name, indication of apartment, direction information of the household.	Census > Households > Addresses
<b>Address 2</b>	Additional address information.	Census > Households > Addresses

Field	Definition	Field Location
<b>City</b>	Name of the city in which the household resides.	Census > Households > Addresses
<b>State</b>	State abbreviation in which the household resides.	Census > Households > Addresses
<b>Zip Code</b>	Zip code (plus 4) of the mailing address of the household.	Census > Households > Addresses
<b>Student Number</b>	District-assigned number associated with the student.	Census > People > Demographics > Person Identifiers
<b>State ID</b>	State-assigned number associated with the student.	Census > People > Demographics > Person Identifiers

An export date exists on the Feeder Import tab that indicates the date the students were extracted from the sending district. This field could be added to the [Ad hoc Filter](#) to find recently added students.
