Select the appropriate **Ed-Fi Code** for the Identity Birth Country Descriptors Overrides.

The Birth Country Descriptors Override mapping only needs to be populated if the code

Select the appropriate **Ed-Fi Code** for the Identity Birth State Abbreviation Types Overrides.
