DIND-1: Directional Indicator - Instruction Type

Instructions: Enter the best suited option during the school year at this school.

(For all schools and justice facilities, preschool-grade 12, ungraded.)

- A. We offered only in-person instruction with additional safety precautions because of the coronavirus pandemic.
- B. We offered only virtual instruction because of the coronavirus pandemic.
- C. We offered a hybrid of in-person and virtual instruction (e.g., some students received in-person instruction while others received virtual instruction; all students received virtual instruction during the first school semester, but during the second semester, some students received virtual instruction while others received in-person instruction) because of the coronavirus pandemic.
- D. There was no effect on the instruction we offered because of the coronavirus pandemic.
