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
Classic View: Scheduling > Section Templates > Section Templates

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Section Templates allow users to define the meeting pattern of a section (Period Schedule, Period and duration) for section placement in a calendar that has a complex schedule structure. Each meeting pattern is captured in a template. The set of all possible meeting patterns for a section are stored in template groups. Template groups are then assigned to courses, and are used to place the course section in the correct location on the White Board when using Schedule Wizard.

Users create Template Groups and Section Templates for every term in the calendar, and should reflect where courses can be placed in the periods.




In the image above, a **Template Group** is created for a three day rotation schedule (A/B/C Days) where all periods meet on Day A, periods 1-4 meet on Day B, and periods 5-8 meet on Day C. This Template Group is named **ABC Group**. Then, a **Section Template** is created for courses meeting **Day A Period 1** that also meet **Day B Period 1** for the entire year, called **Template A1B1** (image below), where the Section Schedule Placement grid is marked for Period 1 Day A and B for



every term.



A second section template is created for courses meeting **Day A Period 2** that also meet **Day B Period 2**. This is called **Template A2B2** (image below).






This process continues until all periods have been marked to meet in a certain day combination. When finished, eight templates are created, so each period that meets on Day A has a corresponding meeting time in the other day rotations.

Create New Template Groups

- 1. Click the **New Group** icon. A **Section Template Group** editor displays.
- Enter the Name of the Section Template Group. This group displays in the Section
 Template tree to the left of this field and is the value that can be assigned to courses on the Course Editor and on the Course Planner.
- 3. Click the **Save** icon when finished. The new group saves and displays in the Section Template tree in alphabetical order.



Group names display with a numeric value in parentheses behind the group name. This value indicates the number of templates associated with the group.

After Template Groups are created, do the following:


- Modify existing template group names by selecting the group name from the tree and entering a different name.
- Create new templates.
- Auto-generate Section Templates.

Create New Templates

- 1. Click the **New Template** icon. A Section Template editor displays, along with a Section Schedule Placement grid.
- 2. Select the Template Group to associate with the new section templates from the dropdown list.
- 3. Enter a **Name** for the Section Template. This name can be reflective of when it is assigned, like "Quarter 1 Day A," or it can be reflective of the courses that will be assigned to that group, like "Fine Arts Placement."
- 4. Mark on the **Section Schedule Placement** grid where courses assigned to this Template Group can be placed for the entire calendar year (all terms).
- 5. Click the **Save** icon when finished.
- 6. Or, if more templates need to be created for the same group, click the Save and Add Template icon. This saves the current record and resets the Section Template editor and Section Schedule Placement grid for entry of another template.
- 7. Repeat the process of saving and creating templates for each term and period combination



for your courses as needed.



Using the image above as reference, when marking on the Section Schedule Placement grid:


- If courses assigned to the Section Template can meet in Period 1 in every term, mark the leftmost checkbox next to Period 1. This marks all of the periods across all schedule structures (days) and terms.
- If courses assigned to the Section Template can meet on Day A in Term 1, mark the upper most checkbox just below Day A. This marks all of the periods for Day A in Term 1.
- If courses assigned to the Section Template can meet in any available days in any period in the first term, mark the checkbox next to the name of the term. This marks all of the periods across all of the days in Term 1.

Verify Template Placement

Once checkboxes have been marked on the Section Schedule Template, either manually or by using the Generate Section Template tool, use the **Show Overlaps** and **Show Empty** options to verify placement of templates.

These options only display when the Template Group name is selected AND there is an issue in the Section Templates that would cause an overlap or where an empty period exists. It does not necessarily mean there is an issue with the setup, but it should be verified that is the intended selection.






In the image above, Alpha Group Three has two templates associated with it - a Tuesday Program and a Wednesday Program. Both programs are marked to meet on Day C during all periods. This is considered an overlap and should be modified before the template is assigned to courses.

Overlaps

- 1. Click the **Group Name** in the Section Template tree. This displays a non-editable Section Schedule Placement grid with two buttons Show Overlaps and Show Empty.
- 2. Click the **Show Overlaps** button. The periods/days where the two templates overlap are highlighted in dark black color surrounding the checkboxes.

In the example below, Period 2 on Day B is highlighted, meaning there are multiple Section Templates where this period is marked.




When the Show Overlaps button is selected and the checkboxes are highlighted on the grid, the button changes to **Hide Overlaps**, allowing the user to not show the dark black coloring around the checkboxes.



Empty

- 1. Click the **Group Name** in the Section Template tree. This displays a non-editable Section Schedule Placement grid with two buttons Show Overlaps and Show Empty.
- 2. Click the **Show Empty** button. The periods/days that are not marked for the periods are highlighted in a white color surrounding the checkboxes.

In this example below, Period 3 on Day B is highlighted, indicating one of the Section Templates does not have this period marked.



When the Show Empty button is selected and the checkboxes are highlighted on the grid, the button changes to **Hide Empty**, allowing the user to not show the highlight around the checkboxes.


Delete Section Templates

To remove Template Groups and Templates, click the **Delete** icon from either the Group level or the Template level.

- Clicking **Delete** at the Group level deletes the group name and any templates associated with it, along with the assignment of the template to any course (the course does not delete, just the assignment of the template to the courses). If the template group is assigned to a course, the warning message indicates the total number of courses to which it is assigned.
- Clicking **Delete** at the Template level deletes the template.

To delete multiple templates, click the **Delete Multiple Templates** icon. This displays a Delete Multiple Templates editor. For the selected group, select which templates to delete. If there are many templates to delete, click the Select All checkbox.





Template groups and sections can be deleted at any time. If the template group is assigned to courses on the Course Planner as part of the scheduling process, deletion of the templates does not affect sections that may already be placed. However, if a template is deleted or otherwise modified, the change to the template affects any section that is not currently placed.
