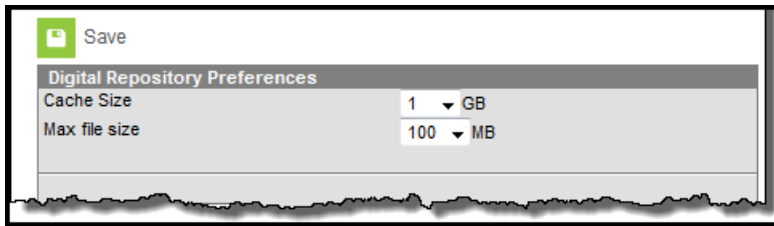

Common File Sizes

The following information can be used as a reference for common files sizes. Files that include images are commonly larger than those that don't.

- 1000 KB = 1 MB
- 1000 MB = 1 GB

File Type	Size
2 page Word document	Less than 20 KB
20 slide PowerPoint	Roughly 1 MB
25 page PDF	Roughly 2 MB
1 MP3	Roughly 3-6 MB
