


# Assessment Tool (Idaho CTE Tooling)

The Assessment Tool extract reports state assessment data, replacing historic ISAT 10 and TSA Performance Measures file types.

## Report Logic

A record report for each student's selected state assessment with a date on or within the extract date range. Students MUST have a State ID to report.

## Generating the CTE Attendance Tooling

1. Select the **Tooling Type** of *Assessment Tool*.
2. If desired, limit results by selecting one or more **Assessment State Codes**.
3. Enter a **Start Date** in *mmddyyyy* format or by clicking the calendar icon and selecting a date.
4. Enter an **End Date** in *mmddyyyy* format or by clicking the calendar icon and selecting a date.
5. Limit the results reported by selecting a **Grade** or an **Ad hoc Filter**.
6. Select the **Format** by using the dropdown list.
7. Select a **Calendar** from the list. More than one can be selected.
8. Click **Generate Extract**. to generate the report in the indicated format or **Submit to Batch** to

schedule when the report will generate.

Users have the option of submitting a Student Assessment report request to the batch queue by clicking **Submit to Batch** instead of Generate Extract. This process will allow larger reports to generate in the background, without disrupting the use of Campus. ## Report Layout

Results are sorted by Student Last Name, then Student State ID, then by Assessment Date.

<b>StudentFirstName</b>	The student's first name.  <i>Alphanumeric, 35 characters</i>	Census > People > Demographics > Person Information > First Name  Identity.firstName
<b>StateGradeLevelCode</b>	The state grade level mapped to the grade in which the student is enrolled.  <i>Numeric, 2 digits</i>	Calendar > Calendar > Grade Levels > State Grade Level; Student Information > General > Enrollments > Grade Level  GradeLevel.stateCode
<b>AssessmentStateCode</b>	The State Code selected for the assessment of record.  <i>Alphanumeric</i>	Assessment > Test Setup > Test Detail > State Test > State Code  Test.stateCode
<b>AssessmentName</b>	The name of the assessment of record.  <i>Alphanumeric</i>	Assessment > Test Setup > Test Detail > State Test > Name  Test.name

<b>AssessmentGradeLevel</b>	The grade level selected for the assessment of record.  <i>Alphanumeric</i>	Assessment > Test Setup > Test Detail > State Test > Grade Level  Test.gradeLevel
<b>AssessmentSubject</b>	The subject selected for the assessment of record.  <i>Alphanumeric</i>	Assessment > Test Setup > Test Detail > State Test > Subject  Test.subject
<b>TestDate</b>	The date on which the student took the assessment.  <i>Alphanumeric</i>	Student Information > General > Assessment > Test Scores > Date  TestScore.date
<b>ScaleScore</b>	The scale score recorded for the assessment.  <i>Alphanumeric</i>	Student Information > General > Assessment > Test Scores > Scale Score  TestScore.scaleScore
<b>RawScore</b>	The raw score recorded for the assessment.  <i>Alphanumeric</i>	Student Information > General > Assessment > Test Scores > Raw Score  TestScore.rawScore
<b>Result</b>	The result recorded for the assessment.  <i>Alphanumeric</i>	Student Information > General > Assessment > Test Scores > Result  TestScore.result
<b>Proficiency</b>	The proficiency level recorded for the assessment.  <i>Alphanumeric</i>	Student Information > General > Assessment > Test Scores > Proficiency  TestScore.proficiency
