The purpose of this data collection is to gather CSEP (Choice Scholarship Education Plan), EL (English Learner) and/or 504 student accommodation information used to populate student-level information for online testing and barcode labels for the ILEARN, IREAD-3 (first time testers and re-testers), and ISTEP+ Grade 10 (first time testers and re-testers) assessments during the 2018-2019 school year.

<b>IREAD3</b>	<p>Reports all students that meet the reporting criteria as of the date the report is run which includes all students with a Test Accommodation record tied to the IREAD-3 Assessment (Test with Standard Code 9975).</p>
<b>ILEARN</b>	<p>Reports all students that meet the reporting criteria as of the date the report is run. To report, students must have a Test Accommodation record tied to one of the following Assessments:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 09901: ILEARN ELA</li> <li>• 09902: ILEARN Math</li> <li>• 09903: ILEARN Science</li> <li>• 09904: ILEARN Social Studies</li> </ul> <p>If the student has multiple records tied to a different ILEARN Assessment, a row reports for each Assessment.</p>

## Report Editor

<b>Choose Grades</b>	Select specific grades to narrow your report results.
<b>Ad Hoc Filter</b>	Select a specific filter to further narrow your report results
<b>Format</b>	Determines the format for the report. Use <b>CSV</b> when submitting the final data. Use <b>HTML</b> for data review and testing.

Field	Description
<b>Select Calendars</b>	The calendar(s) from which data is pulled for the report.
<b>Generate Report Submit to Batch</b>	Users have the option of submitting the report request to the batch queue by clicking <b>Submit to Batch</b> instead of <b>Generate Extract</b> . This process allows larger reports to generate in the background without disrupting the use of Campus.
