

Evaluation (Missouri)


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The Individual Education Program (IEP) or Evaluation team uses the Evaluation to document the student's educational needs and the student's determination of eligibility for special education.

The current print format of the Evaluation is the **MO ESR** format. Evaluation formats are selected in Eval Types.



An evaluation must be created whether or not the student is determined to have a disability. A copy of the evaluation summary report, including the documentation of eligibility, is given to the student's parents by the school district.

Evaluation Editors

The following table lists the editors available on the student's Evaluation, a Description of what the editor is used for and any special considerations and instructions for using the editor.

Editor	Description	Special Considerations and Instructions
Evaluation Header	The Evaluation Header editor is used to define the Evaluation type and corresponding dates.	This editor must be saved before continuing on to other editors.

Background Information	The Parent and Background Information editor is used to document the reasons for referral, as well as parent and school personnel information.	Template Banks are established in System Administration and available by clicking the white paper icon.
Intellectual Information	The Intellectual Information editor is used to document the student's assessment results.	Template Banks are established in System Administration and available by clicking the white paper icon.
Academic Information	The Academic Information editor is used to document student's academic information.	Template Banks are established in System Administration and available by clicking the white paper icon.
Communication Information	The Communication Information editor is used to document student's communication skills.	Template Banks are established in System Administration and available by clicking the white paper icon.
Motor Information	The Motor Information editor is used to document the student's transportation information.	Template Banks are established in System Administration and available by clicking the white paper icon.

Functional Information	The Functional Information editor is used to document the student's functional assessment information.	Template Banks are established in System Administration and available by clicking the white paper icon.
Health Information	The Health Information editor is used to document the sensory, health, and physical status of the student.	Template Banks are established in System Administration and available by clicking the white paper icon.
Social Information	The Social Information editor is used to document the emotional, social, and behavior development of the student.	Template Banks are established in System Administration and available by clicking the white paper icon.

Classroom Observations	The Classroom Observations editor is used to document any observations of the student's participation in the classroom.	Template Banks are established in System Administration and available by clicking the white paper icon.

Interpretation of Results	The Interpretation of Results editor is used to document the determination of the evaluation team based on the assessments documented in the previous editors. This editor describes the interpretation of results based on eligibility criteria and the student's learner based special education needs.
