This code is used for students presented at the school for registration who may or may not have documentation due to a disaster or crisis. Disasters may include but are not limited to natural, civil, or health crisis, conflict, or a disaster-induced event.

The values available in the dropdown are located in a locked Attribute Dictionary (System Administration > Custom > Attribute/Dictionary > Crisis Event > Crisis Code).

- Civil: Civil conflict-induced
- Health: Health crisis-induced
- Natural: Natural disaster-induced
- Other: Other crisis-induced
