This tab allows users to add, edit, or delete Residential Facility student records. Users may also print a summary of all Residential Facility records for the selected student.

A Residential Facility is considered a facility that provides 24-hour custody or care of students with disabilities 22 years of age or younger for detention, treatment, foster care, or any non-educational purpose.
