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
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Classic View: VT State Reporting > SECT Reports > Student Transcript Report

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SECT Reporting is now handled through the SLDS Reports. The SECT Reports are no longer collected by the State of Vermont. These reports will be removed as of the Campus.2235 Release (August 2022).

The Vermont Department of Education uses the Student Transcript Report to associate students with school courses.

Report Logic

- Students with any enrollment that is on or in the active Effective Date window of the Report Editor.
- Courses must have an SCED code assigned to the course (Course > Course Editor > NCES Data > NCES
 Code) OR a State Code assigned at Course > Course Information > State Code.
