A Graduation Plan is a standard plan defined by an education organization outlining required credits and credits by subject that are required for graduation and is reported via Ed-Fi. Elements of a Graduation Plan include the following:

- graduationPlanTypeDescriptor
- educationOrganizationId
- schoolYear
- academicSubjectDescriptor
- Credits
- totalRequiredCredits
- communityService
- civicsExam
- miscellaneousRequiredCredits
- nonHsHealthEducationCredits

The following provides information on how to set up a Graduation Plan to report correctly to Ed-Fi.

Only 1 record reports for the district and is based on a mapped Graduation Program set up in Program Admin > Programs > Graduation Programs.

Graduation Plan Setup

To report a Graduation Plan record to Ed-Fi, create a new plan or edit an existing program with the following parameters:

- 1. Navigate to Program Admin > Programs > Graduation Programs
- 2. Mark the **Active** checkbox.
- 3. Set the Code field to EDFI.
- 4. Select Graduation as the Category.
- 5. Mark the State Reported checkbox.
- 6. Set the **Cohort/Graduation Active Start and End Years** with the correct years. The end year for the program that is reporting needs to be the current year.
- 7. Select the appropriate Credit Group.



8. For the selected Graduation Program, go to the **Credit Requirements** (a school calendar needs to be selected) and populate the credits for the Credit Types/Subjects. The total credits are reported, but not reported by year.
