

# IBM Cash Drawer Installation

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The following installation instructions have been made available for districts who use IBM Cash Drawers for their Point of Sale system.

Step	Description	Notes
1	<p>Download one of the following IBM installer packages from the Infinite Campus support (FTP) site.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>32 bit installation package: <a href="#">Campus_POS_IBM_32.zip</a> (131MB)</li> <li>64 bit installation package: <a href="#">Campus_POS_IBM_64.zip</a> (141MB)</li> </ul>	You can burn the zip file onto a disk or download and save the zip file directly to the POS terminal.
2	Unzip the contents of the zip file into a local directory.	Most compression applications default to the existing directory.
3	Click the <b>setup.bat</b> file.	A confirmation message will display: This process will install the IBM drivers and may take up to 5 minutes. Do you wish to continue?
4	Click <b>Yes</b> on the confirmation message.	Multiple command line windows will appear and quickly disappear (speed dependent upon hardware). A confirmation message will display when the installation is complete: IBM driver installation complete.
5	Validate the <b>C:\POS</b> directory now exists and the start menu shortcut <b>Toshiba UnifiedPOS for Windows</b> now exists in Start > All Programs > Toshiba UnifiedPOS for Windows.	The process is complete. In the future, if you need to reinstall the OPOS drivers for IBM, use the Windows uninstall feature to remove the existing installation and re-run the appropriate (32bit, 64bit) installation package.
