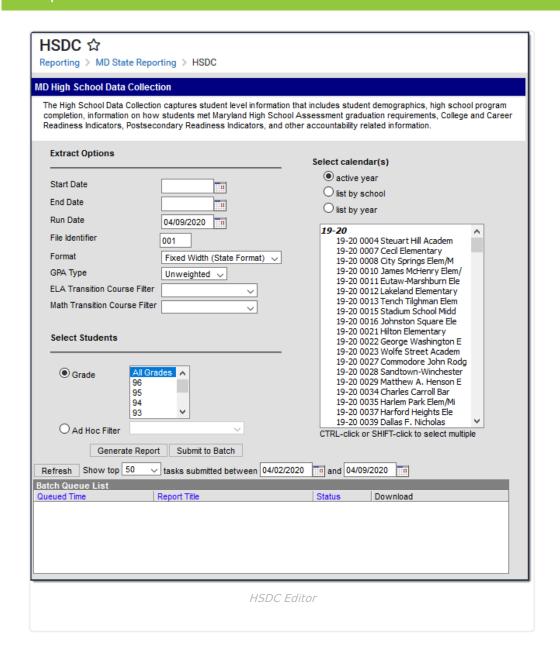

The High School Data Collection captures student level information that includes student demographics, high school program completion, information on how students met Maryland High School Assessment graduation requirements, College and Career Readiness Indicators, Postsecondary Readiness Indicators, and other accountability related information.

This report collects the following information:

- Student Demographic Data
- High School Assessment Status and Scale Scores
- College and Career Readiness Data
- High School Completers Data
- Accountability Measures





Report Logic

- Students report if they meet all of the following criteria:
 - Must have an enrollment in the calendar through the End Date selected on the extract editor.
 - The student's enrollment is active on the last instructional day of the school year OR their Enrollment End Status is C60, C62, or C70.
 - The Enrollment type must be primary enrollment, partial, or special ed services enrollment.
- Students must meet one of the following criteria:
 - Enrollment was active in the selected calendar on an Instructional and Attendance
 Calendar Day before the End Date in the extract editor.
 - Graduation Diploma Date between July 1 and August 31 of the School Year Start Year .
- If a student has more than one enrollment that meets the previous requirements, only the most recent enrollment reports.
- Students are NOT included if
 - their enrollment record is marked as State Exclude;



- their enrollment record is marked as No Show;
- their grade level of enrollment is marked as State Exclude; or
- their Calendar of enrollment is marked as State Exclude.
