

Immunization Rules (Oklahoma) [.2215 and previous]

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Health vaccines and their associated compliance listings are based on state guidelines. While Infinite Campus maintains standard guidelines for all states, districts have the ability to enter additional compliances. The following information describes vaccine compliance rules as defined by the Oklahoma State Department of Health.

General Compliance

- Vaccine doses administered less than or equal to 4 days before the minimum interval or age shall be counted as valid.
- Doses administered 5 days earlier than the minimum interval or age shall not be counted as valid doses and shall be repeated as age-appropriate.

4 doses PK <i>Compliant</i>	 Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: the student is in state grade: PK3F: Pre-Kindergarten Full-day 3-year-old, PK3H: Pre-Kindergarten Half-day 3-year-old, PK4F: Pre-Kindergarten Full-day, PK4H: Pre-Kindergarten Half-day, and the student receives four doses of the DT, Td, Tdap, or DTaP combined vaccine.
5 doses <i>Compliant</i>	 Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: the student is in state grade: KG: Kindergarten Full-day, KG/H: Kindergarten Half-day,01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, the student receives five doses of the DT, Td, Tdap, or DTaP combined vaccine, and the difference between the fifth dose and the student's birthdate is less than 83 months with a 4 day tolerance.
4 doses <i>Compliant</i>	 Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: the student is in state grade: KG: Kindergarten Full-day, KG/H: Kindergarten Half-day,01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, the student receives four doses of the DT, or DTaP combined vaccine, and the difference between the last dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 48 months with a 4 day tolerance.
4 doses with Td <i>Compliant</i>	 Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: the student is in state grade: KG: Kindergarten Full-day, KG/H: Kindergarten Half-day,01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, the student receives four doses of the DT, Td, Tdap, or DTaP combined vaccine, and the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, the difference between the fourth dose and the student's birthdate is less than 131 months with a 5 day tolerance, the student receives one dose of the Td vaccine, and the difference between the dose and the student's birthdate is less than 131 months with a 5 day tolerance.

4 doses with Tdap <i>Compliant</i>	 Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: the student is in state grade: KG: Kindergarten Full-day, KG/H: Kindergarten Half-day,01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, the student receives four doses of the DT, Td, Tdap, or DTaP combined vaccine, and the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, the difference between the last dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 132 months with a 4 day tolerance, the student receives one dose of the Tdap vaccine, and the difference between the dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 132 months with a 4 day tolerance,
3 doses Td In Process	 Students are considered in process if the following conditions have been met: the student receives three doses of the DT, Td, Tdap, or DTaP combined vaccine, and the student receives one dose of the Td vaccine, and the difference between the last dose and the effective date is less than 59 months with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.
3 doses Tdap <i>In Process</i>	 Students are considered in process if the following conditions have been met: the student receives three doses of the DT, Td, Tdap, or DTaP combined vaccine, and the student receives one dose of the Tdap vaccine, and the difference between the last dose and the effective date is less than 119 months with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.

Hepatitis A

Rule	Requirements
2 doses <i>Compliant</i>	 Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: the student receives two doses of the Hepatitis A vaccine, the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, and the difference between the second and previous dose is greater than 6 months with a 4 day tolerance.

Hepatitis B

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Rule	Requirements
3 doses <i>Compliant</i>	Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met:the student receives three doses of the Hepatitis B vaccine.
2 doses <i>Compliant</i>	 Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: the student receives two doses of the Hepatitis B vaccine, the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 132 months with a 4 day tolerance, and the difference between the second dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 6 months with a 4 day tolerance.

MMR



Rule	Requirements
2 MMR <i>Compliant</i>	 Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: the student receives two doses of the MMR or MMRV vaccine, the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, and the difference between the second and previous dose is greater than 28 days with a 4 day tolerance.
2 M,M,R <i>Compliant</i>	 Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: the student receives two doses of the Measles vaccine, the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, and the difference between the second and previous dose is greater than 28 days with a 4 day tolerance, the student receives two doses of the Mumps vaccine, the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, the student receives two doses of the Mumps vaccine, the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, and the difference between the second and previous dose is greater than 28 days with a 4 day tolerance, the student receives two doses of the Rubella vaccine, the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 28 days with a 4 day tolerance, the difference between the second and previous dose is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, and the difference between the second and previous dose is greater than 28 days with a 4 day tolerance.

1 M,M,R Compliant	 Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: the student is in state grade: PK3F: Pre-Kindergarten Full-day 3-year-old, PK3H: Pre-Kindergarten Half-day 3-year-old, PK4F: Pre-Kindergarten Full-day, PK4H: Pre-Kindergarten Half-day, the student receives one dose of the Measles vaccine, and the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, the student receives one dose of the Mumps vaccine, and the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, the student receives one dose of the Rubella vaccine, and the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, the student receives one dose of the Rubella vaccine, and the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance,
1 dose MMR In Progress In Process	 Students are considered in process if the following conditions have been met: the student receives one dose of the MMR or MMRV vaccine, and the difference between the last dose and the effective date is less than 28 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.
1 dose M,M,R In Progress In Process	 Students are considered in process if the following conditions have been met: the student receives one dose of the Measles vaccine, and the difference between the last dose and the effective date is less than 28 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance, the student receives one dose of the Mumps vaccine, and the difference between the last dose and the effective date is less than 28 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance, the student receives one dose of the Mumps vaccine, and the difference between the last dose and the effective date is less than 28 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance, the student receives one dose of the Rubella vaccine, and the difference between the last dose and the effective date is less than 28 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance,

Polio

Rule	Requirements
4 doses <i>Compliant</i>	 Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: the student receives four doses of the IPV, OPV, or IPV/OPV combined vaccine.



Rule	Requirements
3 doses <i>Compliant</i>	 Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: the student receives three doses of the IPV, OPV, or IPV/OPV combined vaccine, and the difference between the last dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 48 months with a 4 day tolerance.
3 doses PK and younger Compliant	 Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: the student is in state grade: PK3F: Pre-Kindergarten Full-day 3-year-old, PK3H: Pre-Kindergarten Half-day 3-year-old, PK4F: Pre-Kindergarten Full-day, PK4H: Pre-Kindergarten Half-day, and the student receives three doses of the IPV, OPV, or IPV/OPV combined vaccine.

Tdap

Rule	Requirements
8-12 2011 <i>No Requirement</i> <i>Active End</i> <i>Date:</i> <i>06/30/2012</i>	Students in state grade: 08, 09, 10, 11, 12 are not required to receive any doses of the Tdap vaccine.
9-12 2012 <i>No Requirement</i> <i>Active End</i> <i>Date:</i> <i>06/30/2013</i>	Students in state grade: 09, 10, 11, 12 are not required to receive any doses of the Tdap vaccine.
10-12 2013 <i>No Requirement</i> <i>Active End</i> <i>Date:</i> <i>06/30/2014</i>	Students in state grade: 10, 11, 12 are not required to receive any doses of the Tdap vaccine.
11-12 2014 <i>No Requirement</i> <i>Active End</i> <i>Date:</i> <i>06/30/2015</i>	Students in state grade: 11, 12 are not required to receive any doses of the Tdap vaccine.
12 2015 <i>No Requirement</i> <i>Active End</i> <i>Date:</i> <i>06/30/2016</i>	Students in state grade: 12 are not required to receive any doses of the Tdap vaccine.



Rule	Requirements
1 dose <i>Compliant</i>	 Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: the student is in state grade: 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, and the student receives one dose of the Tdap vaccine.
Grades 7-12 <i>Non-Compliant</i> <i>Active Start</i> <i>Date:</i> <i>07/01/2011</i>	Students in state grade: 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, with no doses of the Tdap vaccine are considered non-compliant.
