### **Report Logic**

- All Courses set up on or prior to the Effective Date report.
- To report, the course must have an SCED code assigned to the course located in Course > Course Editor > NCES Data > NCES Code.

#### **Report Editor**



Field	Description
Submission Code for File Name	The report naming convention based on the submission time frame of the report.
Extract Type	13 Course Section
Effective Date	The date from which data is pulled for the report.
Format	Determines the format for the report. Use <b>State Submission</b> when submitting the final data. Use <b>HTML</b> for data review and testing.
Select Calendars	The calendar(s) from which data is pulled for the report. This option is only available when you select <i>HTML</i> for the <b>File Format</b> and can assist you with verifying data for individual calendars.
Generate Report Submit to Batch	Users have the option of submitting the report request to the batch queue by clicking <b>Submit to Batch</b> instead of <b>Generate Extract</b> . This process allows larger reports to generate in the background without disrupting the use of Campus.

ADMINID	The VT AOE assigned unique identifier for the Supervisory Union/District that is submitting data.	Alphanumeric, 6 characters	District.number	System Administration > Resources > District Information > District Detail > State District Number

POSID	The VT AOE assigned unique identifier for the organization representing the "Place of Service" where the person is performing a role.	Alphanumeric, 6 characters	School.number	Census > People > District Assignment > Employment Assignments > Teacher AND Census > People > District Assignment > Employment Assignments > School
LOCALCOURSEID	A unique identifier assigned by the school to each of their courses offered in a school year.	Alphanumeric, 55 characters	Course.number	Scheduling > Courses > Course > Course Editor > Number
COURSESECTION	A unique identifier assigned by the school to each of their course sections offered in a given school year. The Course Section number is the Course Number and Section Number combined.	Alphanumeric, 30 characters	Course.number AND Section.number	Course > Course Editor > Number Section > Section Editor > Section

COURSELEVEL	A code identifying the level of rigor at which the course section was offered.	Alphanumeric, 1 character	Course.scedCourseLevel	Course > Course Editor > NCES Data > SCED Course Level
COURSELEVEL CHARACTERISTIC	A code identifying the intended audience that the course section aims to serve.	Alphanumeric, 5 characters	Course.type	Course > Course Editor > Type
COURSECREDITAVAIL	The amount of credits available for successful completion of the course section. By default, this element reports <b>0</b> .	Numeric, 5 digits NN,NN	Course.scedAvailableCredit	Course > Course Editor > NCES Data > SCED Available Credit
COURSESETTING	A code identifying the primary location where the course section took place.	Alphanumeric, 2 digits	Course.teachingMethod	Course > Course Detail > Course Setting
SY	The school year for which data is being submitted.	Numeric, 4 digits YYYY	N/A	N/A
